The verdant garden links through to neighboring Villas Rose and Markisa which provides even more seating and sleeping capacity.

Villa Markisa

Villa Rose

A bit different from The Pala, Villa Rose puts a contemporary twist on the traditional tropical design. Just next to the Pala, Villa Rose offers a choice of open-air living or air-conditioned cool; either way you will surely be treated to a front seat view of the vast blue Indian ocean. An expansive garden area is able to seat a large group of guests for an outdoor ceremony. There are four bedrooms in two floors; rooms are bright, high ceilinged and grand in their scale and are finished in marble, teak and glass.

The ambience is homey but a bit larger than Villa Rose, with an outdoor dining area perfectly designed for outdoor parties.
